TYPE OF PERMIT & FEES

Adult Permit Holders, 18 years or older, are allowed to take members of their immediate family plus three additional guests for whose conduct the Permittee shall be held responsible.

TRAIL USER SHALL

- Sign in on trail register form prior to using EBMUD trails.
- Have, in their possession, a valid Trail Use Permit or be accompanied by a valid Adult Trail Use Permit holder.
- Exhibit and/or surrender permit upon request of EBMUD Ranger, County Law Enforcement Officer, or any other person duly authorized by EBMUD.
- Stay on designated trails.
- Use trails between sunrise and sunset only.
- Close all gates after passing through them.
- Use only designated restroom facilities.
- Carry out and properly dispose of all litter.
- Remove and dispose of their animals' waste products (from staging area.)
- Report unsafe conditions or other hazards to EBMUD.

It is recommended that the trail user carry drinking water and hike or ride with at least one other person.

TRAIL USER SHALL NOT unless otherwise posted or noticed

- Smoke while on trail.
- Build or light any fire on EBMUD property.
- Make body contact with the waters of any reservoir or tributary stream on EBMUD property.
- Fish from any reservoir or tributary stream on EBMUD property.
- Disturb livestock, wildlife, or vegetation on EBMUD property.
- Bring pets, firearms, motorized vehicles, horse-drawn carts or wagons, stallions or colts on EBMUD Trails.
- Damage or destroy any EBMUD property; including (but not limited to) gates, fences, signs, locks, structures, buildings, etc.
- Ride or lead any saddle or pack animal in a manner that might endanger any person or animal, or allow any such animal to stand unattended or untethered on EBMUD property.
- Permit any saddle or pack animal to swim or wade in any reservoir or tributary stream on EBMUD property.
- Ride bicycles on EBMUD trails.
- Use any other EBMUD recreational facilities without paying applicable fees.**

In consideration of issuance of this Trail Use Permit, I agree to abide by the terms and conditions set forth on the face of this form AND to indemnify and hold harmless East Bay Municipal Utility District from and against any and all loss, claim or liability resulting from use of District Property under this permit.
