ORDER AMENDING MAJOR LICENSE

(Issued November 15, 1984)

East Bay Municipal Utility District, Licensee for the constructed Lower Mokelumne River Project No. 2916, filed on October 15, 1984, and amended on October 30, 1984, for Commission approval, as-built Exhibits A, F and G pursuant to Article 36 of its license. ^{1/} The as-built exhibits describe and show the project as finally constructed.

The as-built exhibits have been examined by the staff and found to be in substantial conformance with the Commission's rules and regulations. Exhibits A, F and G describe and show that the project was constructed substantially in conformance with the plans approved by the Commission. The as-built exhibits show that the project does not occupy any United States lands; thus, Article 41(b), pertaining to charges for occupancy of United States lands, will be removed for the license.

Approval of the as-built Exhibits A, F and G is an administrative matter designed to conform the license exhibits to the constructed project and would not authorize any construction or change in the project operation; therefore, it would not be a major Federal action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment.

It is ordered that:

The license for Project No. 2916 is amended, effective the first day of the month in which this order is issued, as follows:

- ^{1/} Authority to act on this matter is delegated to the Director, Division of Project Management, Office of Hydropower Licensing, under §375.314 of the Commission's regulations, 49 Fed. Reg. 29,369 (1984) (Errata issued July 27, 1984) (to be codified at 18 C.F.R. §375.314). This action may be appealed to the Commission by any party within 30 days of the issuance date of this letter pursuant to Rule 1902, 18 C.F.R. §385.1902 (1983). Filing an appeal and final Commission action on that appeal are prerequisites for filing an application for rehearing as provided in Section 313(a) of the Act. Filing an appeal does not operate as a stay of the effective date of this letter or of any other date specified in this letter, except as specifically directed by the Commission.



- (B) Exhibit A, entitled "Description of the project" consisting of 10 typewritten pages, filed on October 15, 1984, is approved and made part of the license.
- (C) Article 41(b) is removed from the license.
- (D) Within 90 days of the date of issuance of this order, the Licensee shall file originals of the approved Exhibits F and G drawings reproduced on silver or gelatin 35 mm microfilm mounted on type D (3 1/4" x 7 3/8") aperture cards. The original set and one duplicate set of aperture cards should be filed with the Secretary of the Commission. The remaining duplicate set of aperture cards should be filed with the Commission's San Francisco Regional Office. FERC drawing numbers shall be shown in the margin below the title block of the microfilmed drawings, and also in the upper right corner of each card.
