## HOW DOES WATER GET TO YOUR HOME?



### Sierra Nevada

Snow falls in the Sierra Nevada and melts into the Mokelumne River watershed.



### Pardee Reservoir

The snowmelt flows downstream in the Mokelumne River and is stored in Pardee Reservoir.



### Mokelumne Aqueducts

Aqueducts carry the water 90 miles from Pardee Reservoir to water treatment plants and reservoirs in the East Bay.



### Reservoir

Reservoirs in the East Bay store untreated water and provide habitat for plants and animals.



### Water Treatment Plant

Water treatment plants test, treat and deliver water to customers in Alameda and Contra Costa Counties.



### Enjoying clean water

We drink the great-tasting water that comes out of the taps in our homes and businesses.



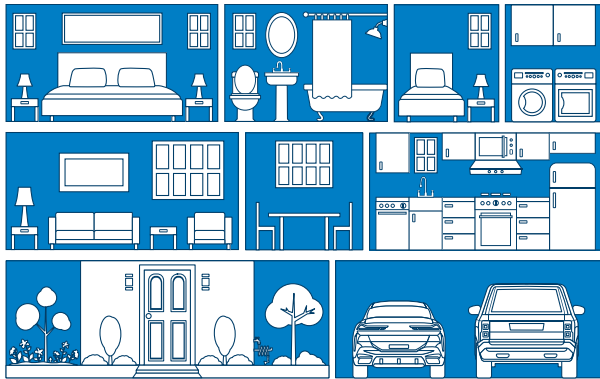
### Main Wastewater Treatment Plant

Our wastewater treatment plants protect public health and the San Francisco Bay ecosystem.

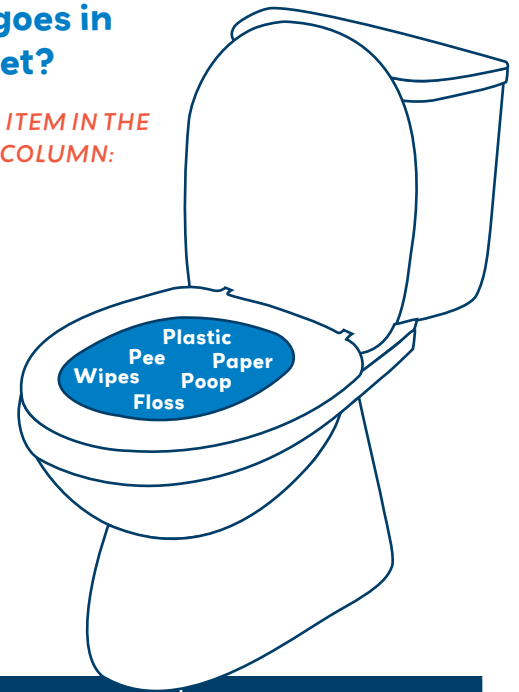
