Traditional Management Practices of Oak Woodlands to Improve Tree Health, Soil Fertility and Water Retention

Dr. Lee Klinger, PhD

What can you do to strengthen Oaks and other stressed native trees? This presentation will cover natural and non-toxic forest management techniques adapted from centuries of Native American traditional knowledge. Learn how to restore native oaks and other trees using techniques such as clearing, pruning, remineralizing, and mulching. Specific methods and materials that can be used by homeowners and land managers will be discussed in detail. New findings on the California native peoples terracing techniques used to improve slope stability and water retention will also be presented.

Dr. Lee Klinger, PhD is an independent scientist. Since 2005 he has served as director of Sudden Oak Life, a movement aimed at using traditional, ecologically-based techniques to address the problem of oak mortality in California and elsewhere. Dr. Klinger has over 30 years of academic experience in the environmental sciences and has held scholarly appointments at the National Center for Atmospheric Research, the University of Colorado, the University of Oxford, and the Chinese Academy of Sciences.
