## **Green Stormwater Infrastructure: Benefits, Construction, Regulations and Challenges**

Rain gardens, bioretention areas, stormwater planters and green roofs, referred to as green stormwater infrastructure (GSI), provide many benefits to the landscape including habitat, aesthetically pleasing green design, flood control, cleaner water and erosion control. Peter Schultz-Allen, Senior Scientist at EOA Inc., and Josh Bradt, SF Estuary Partnership Project Manager, will provide an overview of green stormwater infrastructure terminology, state and local regulations, and steps to design, install and maintain a GSI system.

An update and key features of the San Pablo Avenue Green Stormwater Spine Project will be covered. Detailed information on a typical plant palette, soil media and water conservation metrics will be provided. The meeting will conclude with a facilitated group discussion led by Peter Rosen on the challenges and solutions to specific GSI projects.

### **Bios**

Peter Schultze-Allen, CPSWQ, QSP/QSD, RQP, LEED AP is a Senior Scientist at EOA Inc. He specializes in the integration of public and private green stormwater infrastructure, complete streets, sustainable landscaping, urban forestry practices and provides technical assistance to Bay Area municipalities. Prior to joining EOA Inc., Peter managed environmental programs for the City of Emeryville.

Josh Bradt, Environmental Planner, specializes in green stormwater infrastructure and watershed management and oversees the Bay Area Watershed Network. Prior to joining the SF Estuary Partnership, Josh was the Executive Director of the Urban Creeks Council and spearheaded the City of Berkeley's Watershed Management Plan.

Peter Rosen, QWEL, BFQL, EPA Watersense Partner and President of California Landscape Contractors Association-East Bay (2014-2015) is the Owner of Dynamic Designs Landscape Solutions.
